Position Summary

Alongside the Board of Elders, the Senior Pastor serves as the spiritual leader of our church, guiding our congregation through biblical teaching, pastoral care, and leadership development. This role involves preaching regularly (50%-75% of the time), while also collaborating with and further developing our strong preaching team. The Senior Pastor will oversee staff, cultivate a strong volunteer culture, and help shape the vision and direction of the church in alignment with God's calling.

- Preach regularly while also developing and collaborating with our preaching team.
- Collaborate with staff and volunteers to plan worship services that align with the church's mission.

- Support and develop worship and tech volunteers, ensuring excellence in worship gatherings.

Leadership & Staff Supervision

- Supervise and support our Office staff, ensuring effective church operations.
- Oversee and develop a potential part-time Worship and / or Tech Coordinator.
